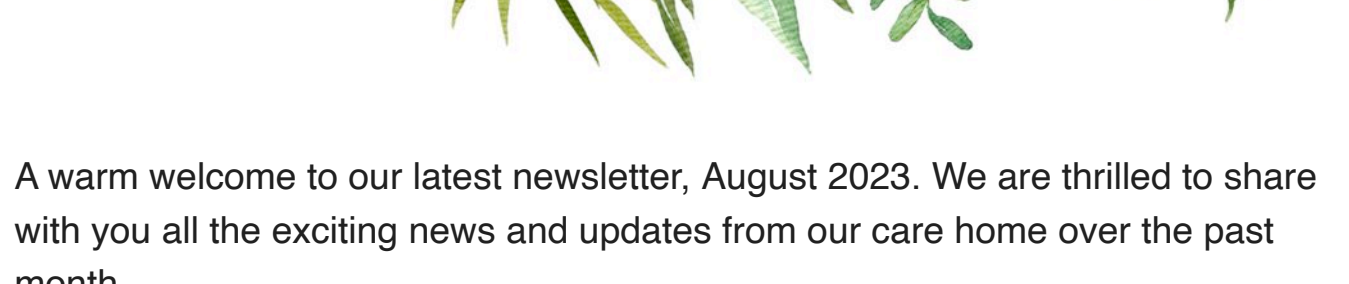




Welcome To Our Newsletter

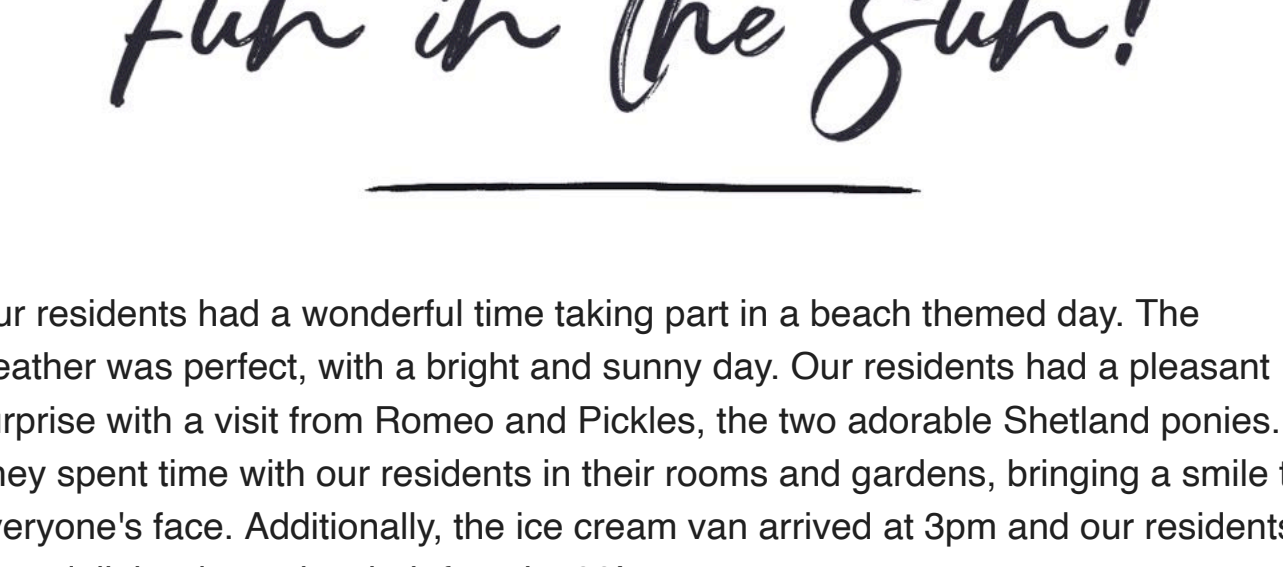

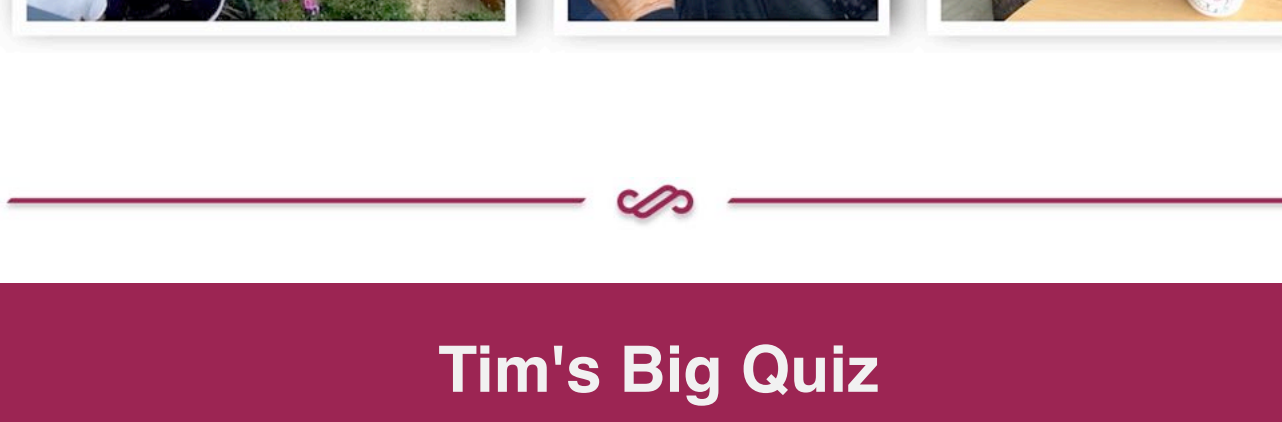


Beach Day

General Knowledge

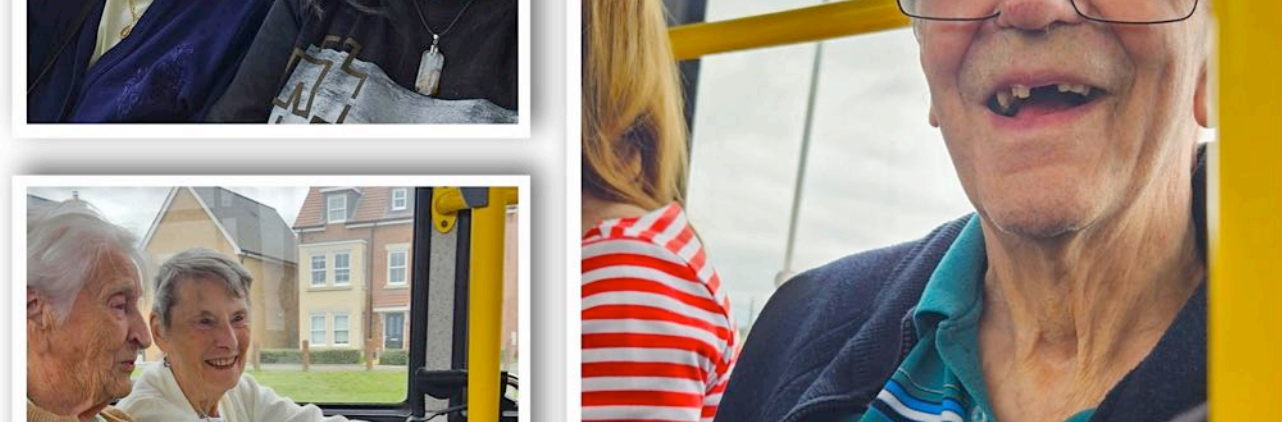

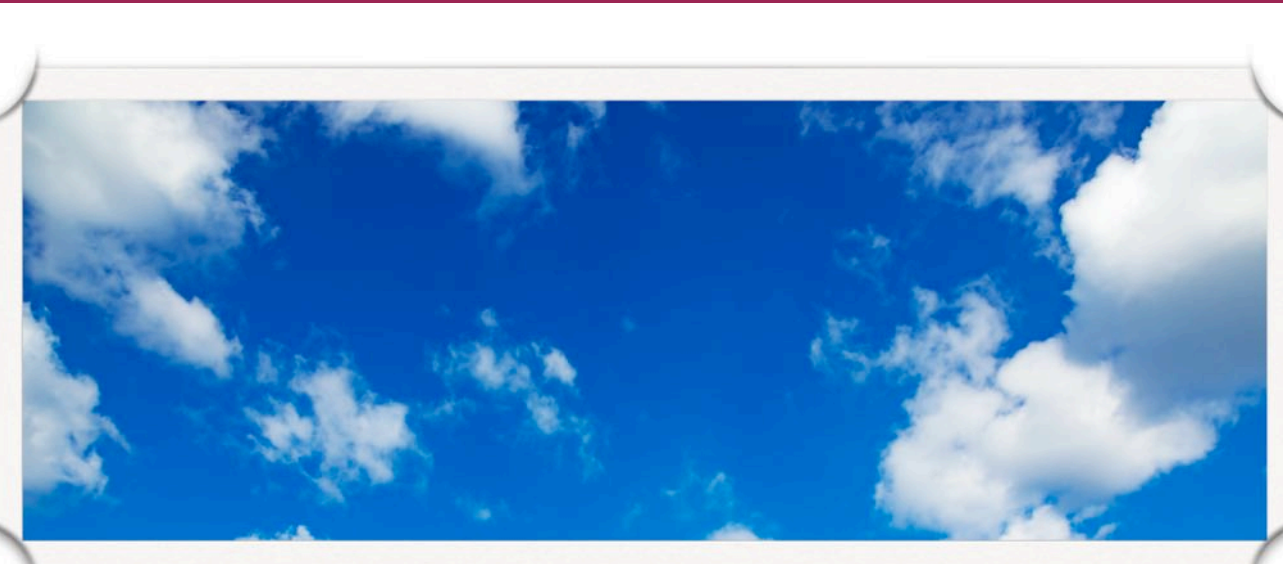
Bus Tour

Summer Sun

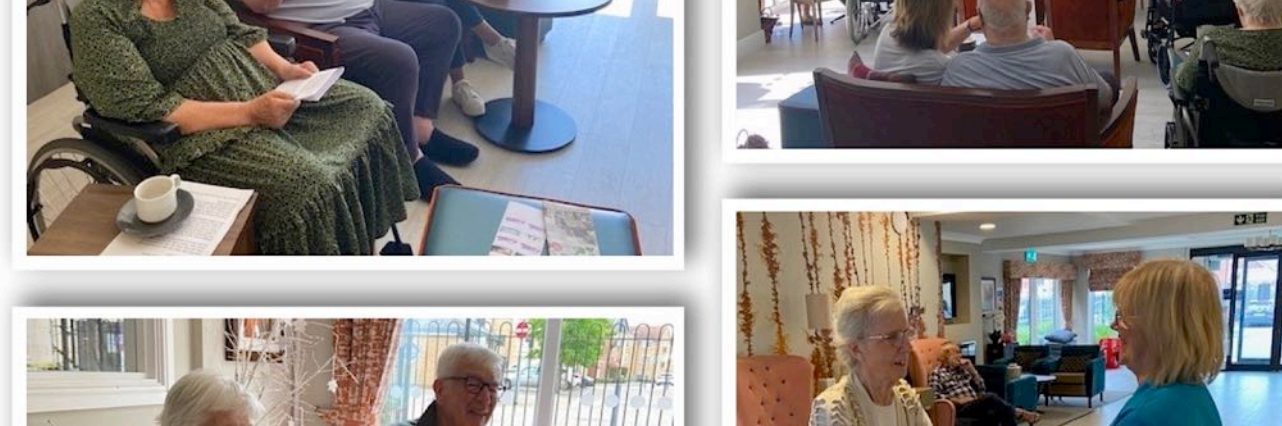

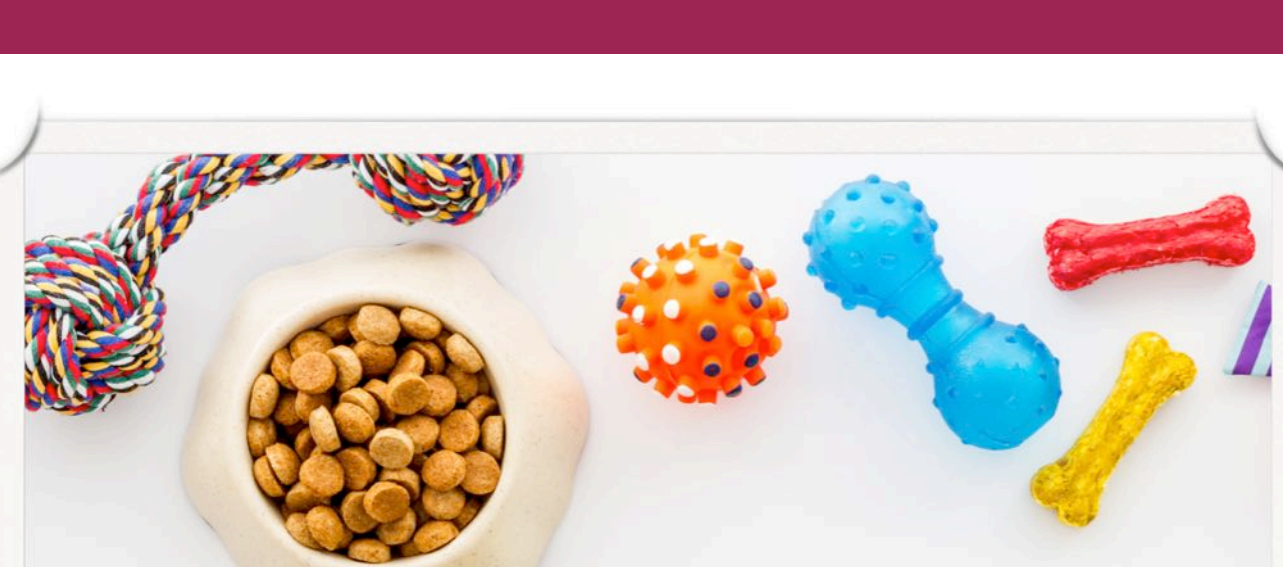
Choir Performance

A Wonderful Day!

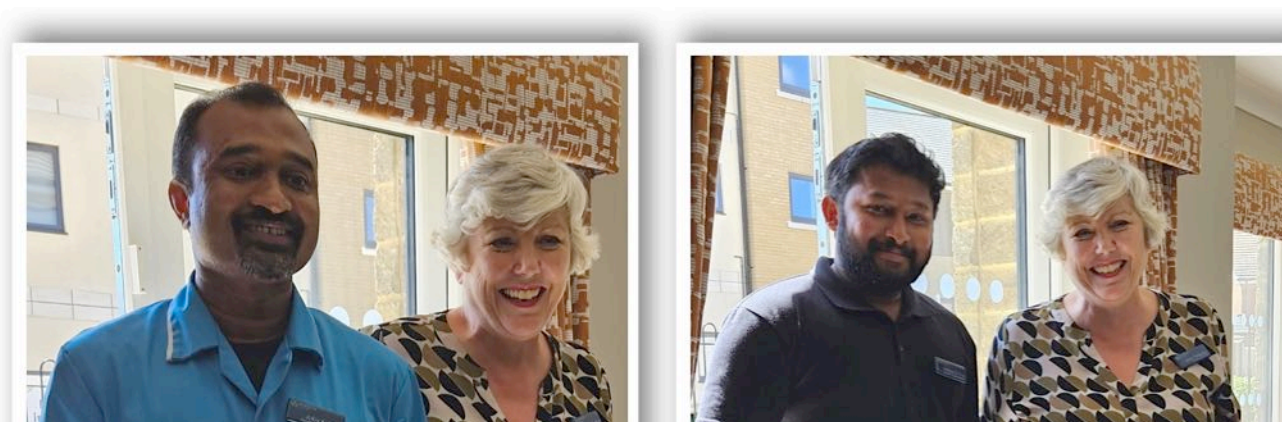

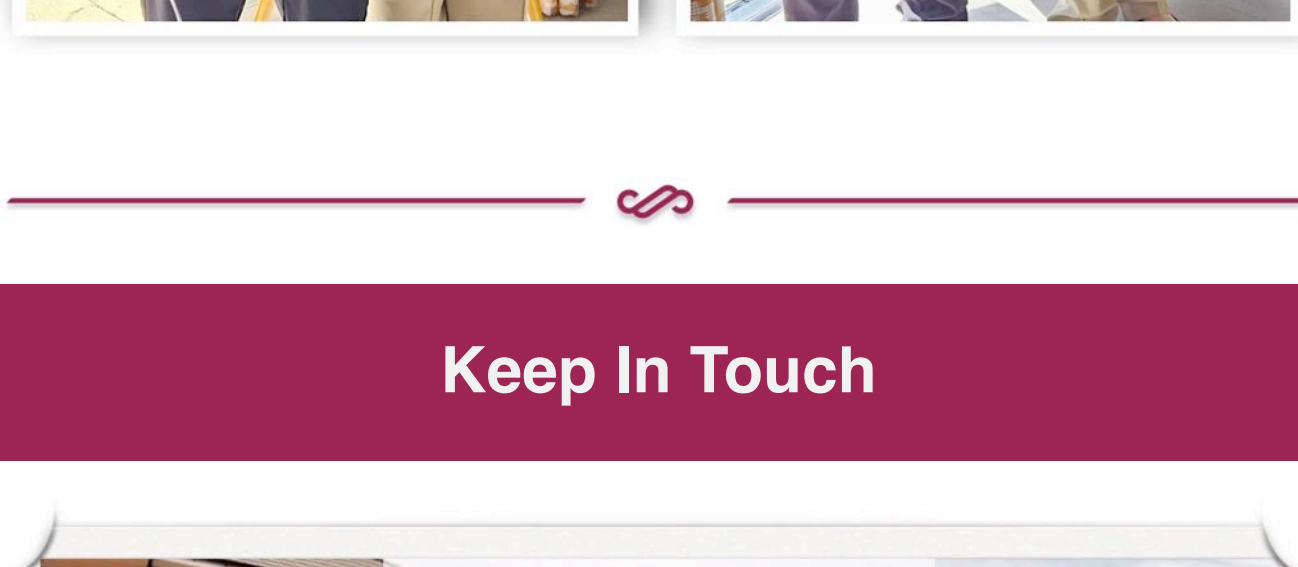
Employees of the Month

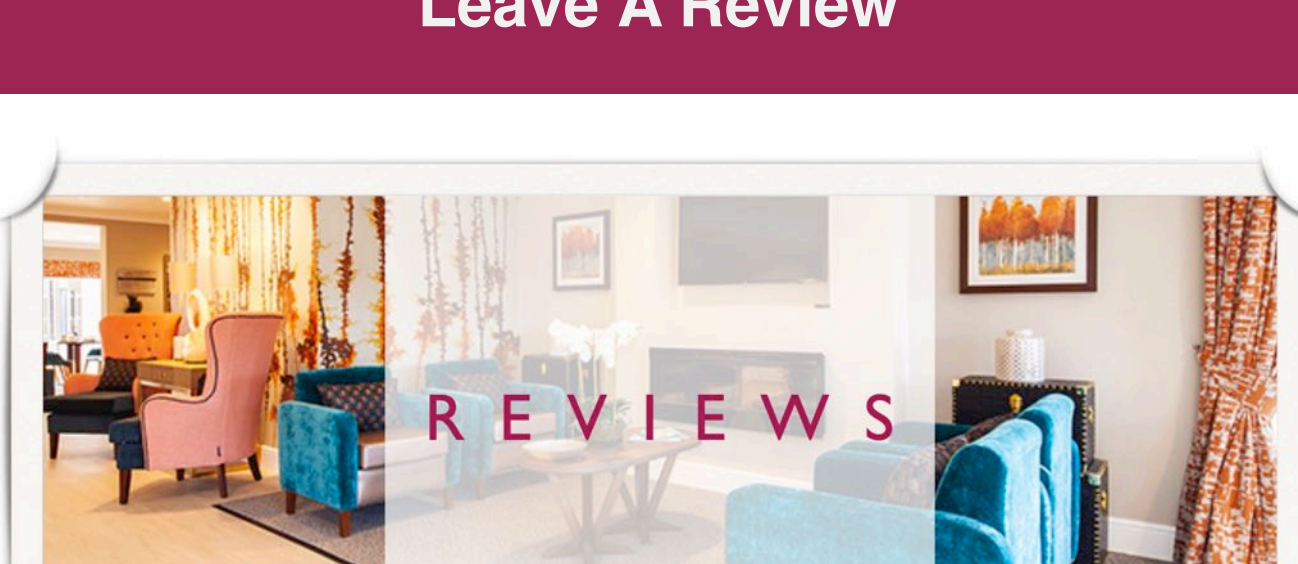

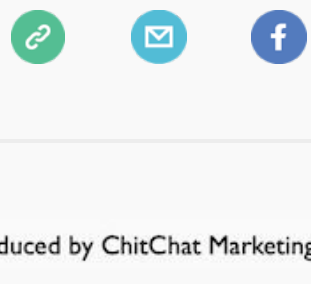
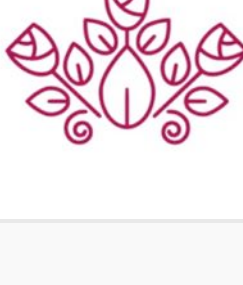
